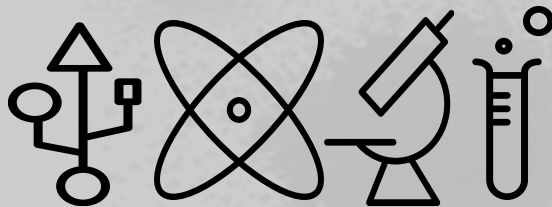

During Active Learning Week we encourage all STEM educators, at all grade levels, to spend at least 10 minutes implementing an active learning strategy in their classrooms.

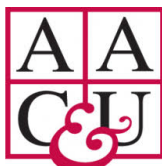
